

Georgia State Council: "What ESA Means to Me" Essay Contest Guide

Each year the Gavelettes sponsor a "What ESA Means to Me" essay contest. You can enter whether you have been a member for 5 minutes or 50 years. You may enter in one of two categories, for members less than one year or for members more than one year. A certificate will be presented by the Gavelettes for the best essay in each category. Please submit your essay to the **Gavelette Vice President** postmarked/or email no later than April 15.

Please note that if a Pledge's first 12 months crosses the fiscal year, they can submit an essay during the first and/or second fiscal year. A pledge can only win one time in "Less Than One Year" category.

A member can only win one time in the "More Than One Year" category.

Please see additional requirements below:

- Must be typed and double spaced
- NO MORE THAN 300 words
- ESA will be counted as one word
- Epsilon Sigma Alpha will be counted as three words
- When submitting your essay please include your category, name, date pledged, and your chapter name and number
- You may submit your essay by mail or by email as an attachment to the Gavelette Vice President

If contestant wishes to enter Headquarters' contest, **contestant is responsible for sending their own entry to ESA Headquarters**. No entries will be returned.
